In July of 2024, while working a summer job in upstate NY, Chloe experienced a blood vessel rupture in her brain from an undiagnosed issue and passed away, devastating her family.

ASIS NYC SCHOLARSHIP

ELIGIBILITY:

- · New or current college student.
- Candidates must be a current college student or planning to attend college/university or a trade school.
- Proof of acceptance and enrollment is required.
- Candidates must be the child of a registered ASIS Member as of January 1, 2025. All children of ASIS members are eligible to apply.

GENERAL CRITERIA AND REQUIREMENTS:

Candidates must submit a 250-500 word essay describing how this scholarship will positively impact your future education. Please include in the essay your connection to ASIS and your future plans after high school graduation.

- 1. A copy of your high school transcript
- 2. A separate activity sheet explaining any school and community activities include details of each activity
- 3. A list of any job/work you have held
- 4. A copy of standardized test score ACT or SAT if taken (optional)
- 5. While academic scores are important to a student's success, this award will focus on the spirit of Chloe's life.

SCHOLARSHIP PRIZES:

There are 2 scholarships to be awarded. Two (2) scholarships for \$5000 each.

PROCEDURE:

The application must be fully complete and submitted to JMartino@doylesecurityservices.com on or before October 1, 2025.

A letter of recommendation must be submitted with your application on or before October 1, 2025. This letter may be from an employer, guidance counselor, teacher, mentor, community leader or other non-family member who can personally attest to the attributes which will be evaluated for this scholarship award.
